  - Will have covered loping and meeting areas
- September Show Counting for Year End Awards Marilyn
  - 2021 September Show did not count
  - Needs to count going forward.
  - Suggestion: Sunday morning brunch rather than Saturday night dinner
  - Tallying Year End Points: Have points tallied going into September Show, then add points from September 2 day Show.
  - If over 12 shows, then must throw out extra shows, so decided to just keep 12 CCC Shows for the year.
