1) COVID-19 and the Fairgrounds for April- Kady Porterfield

- a) Possible event cancelation due to state mandates. Canceling April Show, after CDC event cancelation for the next 8 weeks. Pushing sand install until the end of April to keep the quality of the sand. Panel set up to stay as scheduled. Some of our riders may be at a high-risk population, and with some of the members from Canada it may cause issue. The Fairgrounds can give 100% refund for the April show if we want, or if we want, we can book in October. Parking would be an issue, but Bloom would be available. Fairgrounds will need to do the arena leveling because they cannot get away with volunteer labor for leveling/grading. April 27th would be a great sand haul in date. Get in contact with Jeff Hutchinson for sand haul. Kady will be the contact for Jeff.
- i) Subsequent to this meeting, the scheduling of an October show was done for October 22-24th, and the September show was moved from the 17th-18th to the 18th-20th.

2) Shavings for 2020

- a) Gem Shavings (what we have used in the past) \$7.15/bag Rosebud shavings \$7.50/bag
- i) A motion was made to go with the rosebud shavings.

3) July Youth event-Janie Larson

- a) Over \$4k in prizes including cash and a donated all around saddle. Possible cancelation of HS Rodeo events through April, how this will affect the event.
- i) Will not effect our July cutting if they cancel their early season shows. Will support when it comes.
- ii) Ross got an additional \$300 cash donation for the youth cutting.

4) Sponsorship packet-

- a) Do we agree on the formatting of the sponsorship levels?
- i) It is \$250 and down for the smallest sponsorship.

b) Any new sponsors?

- i) Kelleher ford donated \$1000 to go to the sand fund. Will bring in new trucks for the May show and August show. Windy Chevrolet is looking to do the same. University Auto did not partake.
- ii) KO trading and Scheinder have banners, KO is donating more than \$3000 and Schneider is donating \$1500.
- iii) Ross got a new sponsor Scatter Creek Training Center \$300 to the youth. Ross also had Kiperts and Tack Room Too and King Feed.

c) Banners- Are there any banners needed for the new sponsors? Permission to order this years stallion auction Banners approximately \$640.

- i) A motion was made to approve the movement forward for the banners, it was seconded and all in favor. Erin will work with Nina to come up with the Banner format.

5) Amateur Saddle Format

- a) The Amateur saddle is to come from the stallion auction funds. – Subsequent to this meeting all award saddles are on hold for 2020 and will be planned for 2021.

- a) Scholarship- if we cant have a show, all of the scholarship information will be available online and all will be out by the April show and applications due by may, awards available at the June show. Separate from the July show. The scholarship is also for graduating seniors of 2020.
